An Act to improve the civil service system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 25, Paragraph 3 of Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing  
2           in the 2008 Official Edition, shall be amended by deleting the following:

3           "...;provided, however, that the administrator may revoke the eligibility of the entire list  
4           or of any persons on such list subsequent to said two year period if he shall determine that the  
5           effective maintenance of the merit system so requires such revocation and, provided further, that  
6           a written notice and explanation for said revocation is sent to the clerks of the Senate and House  
7           of Representatives."
