An Act to promote economic development via renewable energy production.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph of subsection (d) the following  
3 paragraph:-

4 Said owner or tenant shall be allowed an additional credit equal to 10 per cent of the net  
5 expenditure for a renewable energy source property or \$1,000, whichever is lesser; provided,  
6 however that the majority of the components of said renewable energy source property,  
7 determined by percentage of retail price, were manufactured in the commonwealth. The  
8 Executive Office of Economic Development shall publish annually a list of manufacturers whose  
9 products shall be considered as manufactured in the commonwealth for the purpose of this credit.
