4 WHEREAS, on November Eleventh of each year since 1919, veterans of the U.S. Armed
5 Services are honored; and

6 WHEREAS, it is desirable to have a uniform time throughout the country when an actual
7 acknowledgment occurs during that day; and

8 WHEREAS, Michael and Daniel Bendetson, students residing in Weston, have suggested
9 that a national two minute moment of silence occur on November Eleventh of each year to
10 observe and honor our veterans; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, that the Massachusetts House of Representatives hereby lends its support to
12 the establishment of a two minute moment of silence at 2p.m. Eastern Standard Time, 1p.m.
13 Central Standard Time, 12p.m. Mountain Standard Time, 11a.m. Pacific Time, 10a.m. Alaskan
14 Standard Time and 9a.m. Hawaiian Standard Time, and to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
15 and its Subdivisions making every effort to participate and encourage participation in said two
16 minute moment of silence.
