An Act exempting Karen Theresa Grasso from maximum age requirement for applying for civil service appointment as a police officer in the town of Middleboro..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION1. Notwithstanding Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law or rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for
3 appointment as a Police Officer, Karen Theresa Grasso of the Town of Middleboro, shall be
4 eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer in the
5 Town of Middleboro notwithstanding his having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil
6 service examination in connection with that appointment. karen T. Grasso shall be eligible for
7 appointment to the position of Police Officer in the Town of Middleboro provided that he meets
8 all other requirements for certification and appointment to this position.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
