An Act relative to the removal or transportation of trash.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 31A of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in lines 4-6 the following words: “;  
3 provided, however, that no rules or regulations shall restrict the hours of the day when garbage,  
4 offal or other offensive substances may be collected in areas zoned for business, commercial or  
5 industrial use”
