An Act enhancing identification of taxicab operators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2   2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, at the end of the third paragraph thereof, the  
3   following sentence:- The name or the trade name of the owner and the name of the city or town  
4   in which it is licensed, the name of the driver, and the plate number, shall be posted inside the  
5   taxicab in a prominent position in one or more locations, so as to be legible and visible to a  
6   passenger in any seat.
