Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word
- 2 "facilities" in section 9E the following:-
- 3 "Physicians may delegate radiological procedures, including procedures using
- 4 fluoroscopy, to a physician assistant who has completed a radiation safety course as prescribed
- 5 by 105 CMR- 120.405."
- 6 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word
- 7 "employed" in Section 5L the following:

- 8 (iii). A Physician Assistant registered under MGL Chapter 111, Section 9C, who has been
- 9 delegated by a supervising physician the performance of radiological procedures including
- 10 fluoroscopy and has completed a radiation safety course as prescribed by 105 CMR 120.405"
