An Act relative to greyhound simulacasting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 203 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by adding the following
2 subsection:-

3 Section 16. Notwithstanding the provisions of this act or any general or special law to the
4 contrary, no racing meeting where simulcast betting or wagering on the speed or ability of dogs
5 occurs shall be conducted or permitted in this commonwealth after be January 1, 2013.
