An Act relative to other tobacco products.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Executive Office of Health and Human Services shall be directed to
- 2 instruct the Department of Public Health to promulgate regulations for restricting the marketing,
- 3 labeling and restricting youth access to so called “Other Tobacco Products”.
