An Act relative to cigar bars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (m) of section 22 of chapter 270 of the General Laws, as so  
2 appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           (6) A local board of health or other municipal health department may make reasonable  
4 restrictions and requirements for the licensed operation of a smoking bar but it shall not  
5 unreasonably restrict or prohibit the operation of a smoking bar if the smoking bar complies with  
6 this chapter.
