- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended: By adding at the end thereof in line 10 the following
- 3 clause, -- "provided however, any violation of a regulation relating to any public health risks, as
- 4 designated by the Board of Registration of Cosmetologists, shall be punished by a fine of up to
- 5 \$1000."
