Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 98 G, as

- a city or town who is empowered to make arrests within a city or town may, while on official
- 4 duty in a city or town that borders their own jurisdiction, take any legal action or exercise any
- 5 lawful act to enforce the General Laws of the Commonwealth.
