Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be a commission established to study the fiscal

2 impact for municipalities to develop, implement and purchase equipment for a system to

3 electronically gather, record and report information concerning motor vehicle accidents,

4 violations and traffic stops and to electronically issue motor vehicle citations.

5 SECTION 2. The following individuals shall be appointed to the

commission:- 2 members of the State Senate to be chosen by the Senate President, 1 member of

the Senate to be chosen by the Minority Leader, 2 members of the House of Representatives to

be chosen by the House Speaker, 1 member of the House of Representatives to be chosen by the

Minority Leader, the Secretary of Public Safety & Security or their designee, 1 member chosen

by the Massachusetts Chiefs of Police Association, and 1 member chosen by the Massachusetts

Police Association. The Secretary of Public Safety & Security shall serve as temporary chair of

the commission and shall convene the commission within 90 days of passage of this act. At the

13 first meeting of said commission a permanent chair shall be elected from among its members.

- 14 The commission shall issue a report on its findings no later than Jan 1, 2012 to the Joint
- 15 Committee on Public Safety, the House Committee on Ways & Means and the Senate
- 16 Committee on Ways & Means.
