- 1 Section 71 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words “not more than five hundred”, in
- 3 lines 3 and 4, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- up to \$5,000.
