An Act relative to the creditable service of Sandra Whitcomb..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2   contrary and in order to promote the public good, the state retirement board shall credit Sandra  
3   Whitcomb with creditable service for the period of October 26, 2007 to September 11, 2010 for  
4   the purpose of determining her superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to paragraph (a) of  
5   subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws. Eligibility for this creditable  
6   service shall be conditioned upon payment by Sandra Whitcomb into the state employees  
7   retirement system an amount equal to the amount that which would have been deducted under  
8   said chapter 32 if she had received regular compensation during this period on an annual rate  
9   equal to the annual rate of regular compensation that she was receiving immediately before this  
10   period, together with regular interest thereon. Such repayment shall be made in 1 sum or in  
11   installments as the state retirement board shall prescribe.
