An Act authorizing the State Board of Retirement to grant creditable service to Kelly Kearns Aveni..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2   contrary and in order to promote the public good, the state retirement board shall credit Kelly  
3   Kearns Aveni with creditable service for the period of September 13, 2002 to February 13, 2005  
4   for the purpose of determining her superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to paragraph  
5   (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws. Eligibility for this  
6   creditable service shall be conditioned upon payment by Kelly Kearns Aveni into the state  
7   employees retirement system an amount equal to the amount that would have been deducted  
8   under said chapter 32 if she had received regular compensation during this period on an annual  
9   rate equal to the annual rate of regular compensation that she was receiving immediately before

- 10 this period together with regular interest thereon. Such repayment shall be made in 1 sum or in
- 11 installments as the state retirement board shall prescribe.
