An Act prohibiting service in an elected public office within one year of retiring from an elected office.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the general laws, as appearing in  
2   the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 85 by inserting after the words “for service  
3   in a public office to which he has thereafter been elected by direct vote of the people” the  
4   following; -

5           provided the position from which he retired was not a public office to which he had been  
6   elected by direct vote of the people, unless one year has passed from the last day he held such  
7   public elected office
