Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 137 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by section 2 of
2 chapter 182 of the acts of 2008, is hereby further amended by striking out section 21 and
3 inserting in place thereof the following section:--

4 Section 21. Section 1 shall expire on September 11, 2014. Sections 2 and 3
5 shall expire on September 11, 2005.
