An Act regarding summer seasonal employees in the Division of State Parks and Recreation in the Department of Conservation..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21 shall be amended by inserting the following new section:-

2 Section 3E. Summer seasonal employees of the Division of State Parks and Recreation in  
3 the Department of Conservation and Recreation who are hired prior to the second Sunday before  
4 Memorial Day and whose employment continues beyond the Saturday following Labor Day shall  
5 be provided health insurance. The Commonwealth shall pay the same percentage of the premium  
6 as for all active state employees.”
