An Act relative to the retirement of University of Massachusetts police..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of  
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 107 of chapter 194 of the  
3 acts of 1998, is hereby further amended by striking out the words “University of Massachusetts  
4 police”.

5                   SECTION 2. Group 4 of said paragraph (g) of said subdivision (2) of said  
6 section 3 of said chapter 32, as appearing in the 1996 official edition, is hereby amended by  
7 inserting after the words “correctional facilities” in line 336 the following words:- Police officers  
8 of the university of Massachusetts.
