**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act allowing municipal employment after retirement..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-  
3 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, any person who is receiving a pension or  
4 retirement allowance from the commonwealth may be employed in the service of a city, town or  
5 district without being subject to the hours and earnings restrictions of the previous sentence.

6           SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of said section 91 of said chapter 32, as so  
7 appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the word “shall”, in line 90, and inserting in place  
8 thereof the following words:- ,with the exception of any person receiving a pension or retirement  
9 allowance from the commonwealth and employed by a city, town or district, shall
