An Act relative to alcohol enforcement equality..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 64 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “license”, in line 3, the following words: - “cancel  
3 his business license and may modify, suspend, revoke, or cancel the total operation of the place  
4 of business”.
