An Act relative to plumbing engineers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the board of registration of  
2 professional engineers and land surveyors, established under section 45 of chapter 13, shall  
3 promulgate rules and regulations to establish and certify the registration of a class of engineer  
4 specifically trained in plumbing.
