An Act authorizing and directing the Teachers' Retirement Board to permit Jeanne Hicks to purchase certain out of state teaching service..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule or  
2 regulation to the contrary, the teacher's retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to  
3 permit Jeanne Hicks to purchase creditable service in the teacher's retirement system for her  
4 public school teaching in New York State under the provisions of subsection four of section  
5 three of chapter thirty-two of the general laws, notwithstanding her receipt of any pension or  
6 retirement allowance as a result of said New York State teaching service; provided, however,  
7 that any increase in Jeanne Hicks's retirement allowance as a result of such purchase of service  
8 shall be reduced by the amount of any New York State pension or retirement allowance to which  
9 she is entitled.

10          SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
