## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial maintenance and other non-teaching employees of school districts..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 59B of Chapter 71 is hereby amended by adding the following
- words at the end of the first paragraph: "In the case of custodial, maintenance and non-teaching
- 3 positions, the hiring, promotion and firing of such employees shall be completed in accordance
- 4 with the provisions of chapter 31 of the general laws provided that said positions are classified as
- 5 civil service positions.? For those positions not covered by civil services, the hiring, promotion
- 6 and firing of such employees shall be completed in accordance with the provisions of the
- 7 existing collective bargaining agreement."
