An Act relative to the board of building regulations and standards.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 94 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as so  
2 appearing, is further amended by inserting after the words “construction supervisors” in line 66,  
3 the following words:- and to assess monetary penalties where appropriate for violations of  
4 regulations pertaining to the license. Such monetary penalties shall not exceed \$2,000 per  
5 violation and shall be determined following a disciplinary hearing.

6                   SECTION 2. Section 94 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as so  
7 appearing, is further amended by inserting after the words “Fees for such licenses” in line 66, the  
8 following words:- and monies collected for monetary penalties.
