An Act relative to applications for inspectors of amusement devices.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 60 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, after the word "boilers" in the first  
3 sentence, the words "or an inspector of amusement devices."

4                   SECTION 2. Section 60 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing,  
5 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "administration," in the first sentence, the  
6 following sentence:-The application of a person desiring to act as an inspector of amusement  
7 devices shall be accompanied by a fee, the amount of which shall be determined annually by the  
8 commissioner of administration.
