An Act amending the sales and use tax exemption for clothing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as so  
2    appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in lines 165 and 166 the  
3    words "one hundred and seventy-five" and inserting in place thereof the following:-- "two  
4    hundred and fifty".
