An Act relative to continuing education requirements for inspectors of boilers and amusement devices..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 62 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:-

4           The department shall promulgate regulations which shall require the renewal of such  
5 certifications every two years. Commencing with the renewal of certification on July 1, 2011, all  
6 individuals certified by the commonwealth as an inspector of boilers or amusement devices shall  
7 demonstrate the satisfactory completion of continuing education courses as determined by the  
8 department.
