An Act relative to continuing education requirements for pipefitters, refrigeration technicians, and sprinkler fitters..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   Section 85 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following  
3   paragraph:-

4                   The Bureau shall promulgate regulations which shall require the renewal of  
5   such licenses every two years. Commencing with the license renewal on July 1, 2011, all  
6   individuals licensed by the commonwealth as a pipefitter, refrigeration technician, or sprinkler  
7   fitter shall demonstrate the satisfactory completion of continuing education courses as  
8   determined by the Bureau.
