An Act relative to service station operation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special act to the contrary the hands free
- 2 mechanism which enables consumers to place motor vehicle fuel into vehicles without requiring
- 3 the consumer to continuously operate the pump shall be operational for all motor vehicle fuel
- 4 pumps in the Commonwealth.
