An Act promoting the use of electric vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SETION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the general laws, as most recently
- 2 appearing, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new subsection:--
- 3 (yy) A battery electric vehicle (BEV), also known as an electric car, together
- 4 with the battery recharging station shall be exempt from the sales tax, provided, however, that
- 5 the owner agrees to pay a vehicle miles traveled tax established by regulation by the department
- 6 of revenue collected as part of any battery rental agreement.
