An Act promoting the use of electric vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the general laws, as most recently  
2 appearing, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new subsection:--

3                   (yy) A battery electric vehicle (BEV), also known as an electric car, together  
4 with the battery recharging station shall be exempt from the sales tax, provided, however, that  
5 the owner agrees to pay a vehicle miles traveled tax established by regulation by the department  
6 of revenue collected as part of any battery rental agreement.
