An Act relative to the assessment of local taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 21 A1/2 of chapter 59 of the general laws, as appearing  
2 in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 6 the words “as a Certified  
3 Massachusetts Assessor” and inserting in place thereof, “as a Massachusetts Accredited  
4 Assessor,”
