Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas, the personal property tax provides no additional revenue to the cities 2 and towns of the commonwealth and; 3 Whereas, municipalities incur unnecessary expense in its administration and; 4 Whereas, the compliance with the reporting requirements represents an undue 5 burden on the residence, let the following be enacted. 6 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 7 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following new clause at the end 8 thereof: Fifty-six, personal property held principally for personal non-commercial use. 9 Commercial use for the purposes of this section shall mean an enterprise whose net income
