An Act relative to the assessments of long term care facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- Any real estate used as  
3   a long term care facility and owned by a Massachusetts entity, as defined in 105 CMR 151.020,  
4   in the Commonwealth shall be deemed exempt from the requirement to pay local real estate  
5   taxes if it: is licensed by the department of public health; is owned by a charitable organization  
6   that has been determined by the Internal Revenue Service to be exempt from taxation pursuant to  
7   26 CFR 501 (c) 3; did not pay local real estate taxes prior to the year 2003; and provides room,  
8   board or care to elders at not more than the cost of delivering such room, board or care; or  
9   provides financial assistance to elders living in such long term care facility utilizing assets of the  
10   charitable organization.
