An Act relative to disclosure of job recommendations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
2 the following new section:-

3                   268B. Any member of the General Court or any Constitutional officer who  
4 directly or indirectly, whether in writing or by other means, recommends an individual for a  
5 position as a public employee or quasi-public employee of the state shall file a written disclosure  
6 of the name and address of the individual who is the subject of the recommendation and the  
7 position and agency for which the recommendation was given. Said disclosure shall be  
8 considered a public record 3 months after it has been filed.
