An Act relative to equitable and transparent public bidding..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Alternative procurement authorized pursuant to Chapter 773 of the  
2 Act of 1960 is hereby stricken; provided further that alternative procurement authorized pursuant  
3 to Chapter 319 of the Acts of 1998 is hereby stricken; provided further that alternative  
4 procurement pursuant to Chapter 703 of the Acts of 1963 and all subsequent amendments  
5 relative to alternative procurement at the Massachusetts State College Building Authority are  
6 hereby stricken; provided further that the provisions of chapter 149, chapter 30, and chapter 7 of  
7 the General Laws, without exception or exemption, shall apply to all procurement and  
8 construction at Massachusetts universities, state colleges and community colleges in the same  
9 manner as the procurement and construction laws apply to any state agency of the  
10 commonwealth; provided further that all capital projects shall be overseen by the division of  
11 capital asset management and maintenance.
