*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   Section 10 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws shall be amended in  
2 subsection b) by adding in the second sentence, after the words “in adoption of demand side  
3 reduction initiatives;” the following: “all or a portion of the salaries of municipal or regional  
4 green community officers;”
