### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

An Act to allow greater responsiveness of telephone rates to consumer demand in a competitive market.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 19 of chapter 159 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following paragraph after the first paragraph:
- Notwithstanding the foregoing paragraph, a telephone company or a common carrier
- 4 furnishing services described in paragraph (d) of section twelve may post on its website the rates,
- 5 terms and conditions of any retail service it offers, renders or furnishes within the
- 6 commonwealth. The foregoing paragraph shall not apply to any service so posted, and such
- 7 company or carrier shall not be required to file with the department or obtain department
- 8 approval of any schedule for such service. Upon written notice to the department, such company
- 9 or carrier may withdraw any schedule, contract or agreement previously filed with the
- department for any service so posted.
