Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 16G of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "development.", in line 23, the
- 3 following sentence:- "The governor shall select the secretary of housing and economic
- 4 development from a pool of candidates representing 4 regions of the Commonwealth defined as:
- 5 East which includes Essex, Middlesex, Suffolk, and Norfolk counties; South which includes
- 6 Bristol, Plymouth, Barnstable, Dukes, and Nantucket counties; Central which includes Worcester
- 7 county; Western which includes Franklin, Hampshire, Hampden, and Berkshire counties.".
