An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Leominster as the Jonathan Roberge Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           The bridge on Nashua Street, spanning the Nashua River, in the city of Leominster shall
- 2   be designated and known as the Jonathan Roberge Memorial Bridge, in memory of Private First
- 3   Class Jonathan Roberge who tragically lost his life in Iraq on February 9, 2009. The
- 4   Massachusetts department of transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing
- 5   that designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
