An Act eliminating the use of capital funds for operating and personnel expenses..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2   2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (e) and inserting in place  
3   thereof the following:-

4                   (e) The commissioner shall terminate the usage of capital funds to pay for personnel and  
5   personnel-related costs, including payroll allocations for budgetary employees, fringe recovery  
6   and other charge-backs, within 5 years of the passage of this act.

7                   SECTION 2. Section 1 of said chapter 16, as so appearing, is hereby further  
8   amend by inserting the following subsection:

9           (f) The commissioner may promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of  
10 this chapter.
