An Act authorizing the Massachusetts Highway Department to install certain signs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any policy or regulation of the Massachusetts  
2 Department of Transportation to the contrary, the department is hereby authorized and directed  
3 to erect and maintain two signs on Route I-395 at exit 5 northbound and southbound in the town  
4 of Oxford marking and directing motorists to the birthplace of Clara Barton, founder of the  
5 American Red Cross, teacher, national heroine, and native of Oxford, Massachusetts.
