Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 2 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws as so appearing is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the word "government" in line 16, the following new words:--
- 3 provided, however, that he shall establish no regulations, procedures or directives that will make
- 4 any veteran or veteran survivor ineligible to receive benefits they would otherwise be eligible to
- 5 receive solely because they failed to complete the application for said benefits within a
- 6 designated period of time.
