### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to Massachusetts veterans..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 16 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as

2 most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 165 of the acts of 2005, is hereby further

3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:-

4 All stores and shops which sell goods at retail may be open at any time on Sundays, July Fourth

5 and Labor Day, but no such stores and shops may be open on Christmas Day if Christmas occurs

6 on a Sunday; and no such store shall open on Memorial Day.
