In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Donna Jean Kelly, an employee of the Trial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose,
2 which is forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the trial court,
3 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
4 of the public convenience.

5 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
6 and by the authority of the same as follows:

7 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
8 the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for Donna Jean Kelly, an employee of the
9 Brockton juvenile court in the department of the trial court. Any employee of the department
10 may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for
11 use by Donna Jean Kelly. Whenever Donna Jean Kelly terminates employment with the
12 department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank
13 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for

- 14 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
- 15 bank as determined by the department.
