The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Caron Parker, an employee of the Department of Revenue.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Revenue, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
2 the Department of Revenue shall establish a sick leave bank for Caron Parker, an employee of
3 the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute one or more sick,
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Caron Parker. Whenever Caron
5 Parker terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,
6 the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the Department of Revenue extended
7 sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or
8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the
9 department.
