The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Scott Hayward, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the
2 contrary, the executive office of health and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for
3 Scott Hayward, an employee of the executive office. Any employee of the executive office may
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by
5 Scott Hayward. Whenever Scott Hayward terminates employment with the executive office or
6 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to
7 the extended sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to
8 the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined
9 by the executive office.
