An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Kevin W. Rose, an employee of the Bristol County Sheriff's office.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Bristol County sheriff's office, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Bristol County sheriff's office shall establish a sick leave bank for Kevin W. Rose, an employee  
3 of the sheriff's office. Any employee of the sheriff's office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more  
4 sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Kevin W. Rose. Whenever  
5 Kevin W. Rose terminates employment with the sheriff's office or requests to dissolve the sick  
6 leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness  
7 leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the sheriff's  
9 office.
